Analysis and Conclusion

This proposal is in response to interpretative questions as to the applicable classification provisions for recreational vehicle (RV), travel trailer or horse trailer window glass. It is the opinion of the FCDC that these articles are appropriately classified as automobile glass under item 86630. Therefore, this proposal would amend Note, item 86631 by adding, “Automobile glass includes glass for recreational vehicles (RVs), travel trailers or horse trailers.” This change would promote clarification and address interpretative issues.
